SPECIAL HORSE REGULATIONS:-

TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE GENERAL REGULATIONS

NO REFUNDS OR EXCHANGES will be made for class entry tickets unused or purchased in error.

Entry tickets are DAY SPECIFIC only.

WAIVERS – Waiver form must be signed by all persons competing or handling horses on the Arena(s). If under 18 a parent or guardian must sign on their behalf.

Pre-nomination of horses and riders. To improve processing of entries on the day of the Show there is now the option to Pre-Nominate your horse/s and/or Rider/s. The form is on page 11 of the Schedule. A copy of the necessary Horse Sports Waiver is on page 12. It is not necessary to list particular classes. Fill out the Nomination Form and Waiver and send in by Friday 11th October and you will be one step ahead in the queue on Show Day! Pay for your class tickets (day specific) in advance and they will all be ready for you at the Horse Ticket Office on the day for collection.

STALLS – LIMITED number of stalls available. Please contact the Secretary for details. Use of stables can only be authorised through the Secretary's Office.

NO STRAW provided. **BYO STRAW. Stalls must be cleaned out after use.**

MEASURING – Current RAS and EFA Measuring cards will be accepted and must be produced on request.

DISTRICT / LOCAL EVENTS – Local or district events are for competitors residing in Benalla and District, or 30km radius.

PERSONAL PUBLIC LIABILITY RISK – is the responsibility of **ALL** competitors.

COLTS and STALLIONS – All colts and stallions 2 years and over must wear a bit at all times, or adequate restraining gear.

OPEN SHOW HUNTERS – Exhibits competing as Show Hunters must not compete in Open Saddle Classes and Open Saddle exhibits may not compete in Show Hunter Classes. Show hunters should have more substance than the riding pony type, but still maintain quality.

CHAMPIONS – per VAS Ltd rule as of 20th November 1997 – **A competitor receiving a Championship in any one of the Open Rings is ineligible from competing in the Open Saddle Class or Show Hunter in any other ring.**

SWABBING – Random swabbing may be enforced.

YARDS – As per EA rules, all yards must be of a fixed material and no electric fences are permitted. Yards are not to exceed 5mx5m.

CAMPING - There is **NO POWER** available due to OH&S.

2013 MEMBERSHIPS – can only be purchased up until Thursday 17th October 2013

Off The Track Series – Qualifiers Regulations

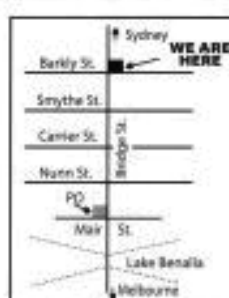
- Open to all thoroughbreds unraced or raced 4 yrs & over, over 14.2hh who are resgitsered with RISA. Registrations will be checked.
- Racing name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name, or if never raced, please provide the following details (if known):
 - Racing name
 - Brands, colour and markings
 - Microchip number
 - Life number
 - Registration Certificate Number
- Qualifying shows must be affiliated with VAS Ltd.
- Qualifying classes will be judged ridden
- Once a qualifier is won the horse cannot compete in other qualifier.
- All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Off The Track series Final to be held at the 2014 VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships on Saturday 4th January 2014.
- Riders to be 14yrs & over on day of qualifying show.
- To be judged as a good example of Thoroughbreds rather than riding horse/hunter types with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Thoroughbred qualities
 - Conformation
 - Manners, paces & performance
 - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
- Judges decision is final in qualifiers & Final.
- Qualifier prizes: \$50, sash, card and Racing Victoria Prize Pack

NAME OF PARTICIPANT:.....

Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd and Benalla Agricultural & Pastoral Society Inc (together “the Suppliers”) advise that participation in horse sports at an agricultural show or horse competition contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. Horse sports are dangerous recreational activities and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

1. By signing this waiver I acknowledged that:
 - 1.1 participation in horse sports is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - 1.2 participation in horse sports requires certain skills. I declare that I have sufficient skills to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
 - 1.3 horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
 - 1.4 if held at an agricultural show, the horse sports will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten horses;
 - 1.5 as the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me and to my horse as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
 - 1.6 insects or other animals may cause my horse or other horses to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way;
 - 1.7 there is inherent in horse riding events the risk of suffering injury including falling from my horse;
 - 1.8 I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for safely and properly participating in the event; and
 - 1.9 I use the facilities of Benalla Agricultural & Pastoral Society Inc entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.
2. If I suffer harm while participating in a horse event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any injuries I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided.
3. I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the horse sports and associated activities are a danger and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur and I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in any way whatsoever arising from or in connection with these activities.
4. I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the horse sports and agree that such use may result in me being excluded from an event with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.
5. I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd as varied from time to time.

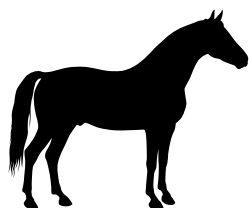
