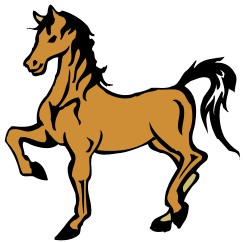

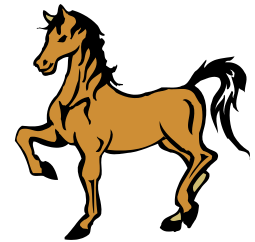
SPECIAL HORSE REGULATIONS

1. The OFFICIAL MEASURER will attend the Showgrounds from 8.00 am on the day of the Show. When measuring a horse, Galloway or pony an allowance of one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of an inch is to be made for shoes. Where an exhibitor disagrees with the Official Measurer's figures for an animal, which has been measured with shoes on, he may, should he so desire, have it re-measured without shoes. The Official Measurer may, at his discretion, request the removal of shoes from any animal prior to measurement.
2. A BIRTH CERTIFICATE may be called for in all age classes and must be produced in Marshalling Yard if requested or entry may be refused.
3. When framing the timetable of judging every endeavour has been made to avoid the judging of two classes at the same time in which one exhibitor may be interested. The Society, however cannot accept responsibility if the judging happens to conflict with one or more classes of events.
4. In cases where age and height is a condition of entry of the next event. Any protest must be made before the completion of judging.
5. Where an error in printing of the Ring Schedule or Timetable has occurred, the ruling of the A. & P. Committee and/or Ring Stewards will be final.
6. Riders will be permitted to "Walk the Course" prior to the commencement of each jumping contest.
7. All jumping contests to be over such obstacles as the Stewards may decide and all riders must wear skull caps and costumes approved by the Stewards. Jumping will be judged under F.E.I. Rules.
8. Novice Entries shall be those who have not previously won a First Prize in the specified class excepting Novice jumping under F.E.I. Rules which state that a Novice is: "Any horse over 14.2 hands which has not won three events conducted under F.E.I. Rules providing that prize money in excess of \$80 in any one event has not been won."
9. Elementary. A horse whilst competing singly has never won and open class, in its particular height group
10. Intermediate. A Horse whilst competing singularly has never placed 1st 2nd or 3rd at an Australian Royal Show.
11. NEWCOMERS – Horses eligible are those eligible to compete on the VAS Ltd First Season and Barastoc Newcomer Sections in 2014. Entries must compete in a snaffle bit.
12. No Stallion will be allowed to enter in any section except led sections and harness, with the exception of Show Jumping, as this is a single horse event.
13. All Stallions to be led with a bit and chain in mouth and handler to be an adult.
14. The use of tranquillizers, stimulants or any drugs capable of affecting the performance or behaviour of animals is forbidden.
15. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under veterinary supervision.
16. **No prize money will be collected before 1:00pm. Trophies and donations have been given to the Society in Good Faith and no correspondence will be entered into of prizes given.**
