- CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**
1. Gates open at 8.30am. First riders can leave at 9. All riders must have commenced by 12.30pm.
 2. This event is an Unofficial HRCav and Open event. Riders compete individually, but may ride in pairs or groups.
JUNIORS MUST BE 16YEARS AND UNDER AND MUST BE PAIRED WITH AN ADULT.
 3. Non HRCav Members MUST:
 - a. Submit a signed 'Non-Member Disclaimer Statement' and agree to abide by HRCav rules. HRCav rules can be viewed on the website www.hrcav.com.au
 - b. Purchase a 'Day Membership' from the organising Club prior to riding. Day membership entitles participants to public liability cover under the HRCav policy on the day of the event from arrival to departure.
 4. Valid HRCav Membership cards and Navigation Ride Cards must be handed to the steward on arrival.
 5. All riders must present for a gear check prior to riding out.
 6. **Saddlery, approved boots and approved helmet as per HRCav Navigation Ride Event Rules are required.**
Medical armbands must be worn. Single buckle girths MUST have a correctly fitting surcingle fitted as per Rule 4.2
 7. Bridle/saddle cloth numbers must be worn on both sides, provided by the rider. Numbers will be assigned on the day of the event.
 8. Standard Entry Forms must be completed and handed in on the day.
 9. The Organising Committee of the Northern SRG reserves the right to refuse entry with or without stating a reason.
 10. Northern SRG strongly recommends that your horse be shod or have hoof protection due to some stony terrain.
 11. Strictly no dogs allowed.
 12. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU REMOVE ALL RUBBISH (INCLUDING MANURE/HAY).
