## REGULATIONS:

1. All postal entries must be received by the Horse Secretary not later than 25th September 2013 and **must be accompanied by entry fees**. Entries not accompanied by fees will not be accepted. All details requested on Entry Form must be supplied. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL TELEPHONE ENTRIES BE ACCEPTED.**
2. Confirmation of entries received will not be recognized unless a **stamped, self-addressed envelope is enclosed**.
3. Children competing **MUST** produce on request a certificate of age from teacher or guardian.
4. Trophies must be collected on day of Show at the Secretary's Office after 2.00pm
5. In any class it will be left to the judge's discretion to award a First Prize
6. Protests against awards must be lodged with the Secretary in writing within 30 minutes after such awards are made, with a deposit of \$20.00. The Committee with or without the judge's advice will decide the question, which decision will be final. If the protest is dismissed and deemed frivolous, deposit may be forfeited.
7. Where height is stipulated, E.F.A. Height Certificates will be accepted but the Committee reserves the right to measure any horse or pony at any time.
8. Any stallion present on the Showgrounds must have a bit in its mouth, or chain controlling halter.
9. Novice means never to have won a First Prize at any registered Agricultural Show.
10. The Committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any event.
11. Breed Classes - Entries must be registered with respective Societies and Stud Books as in R.A.S Schedule. If requested, registration papers must be produced for scrutiny.
12. No stallion shall be permitted in Open Saddle Classes.
13. Random swabbing may take place under V.A.S.L. and E.F.A. Rules.
