STABLES

WILL BE ALLOCATED UPON RECEIVAL ON PAID ENTRY

Loose boxes for overnight accommodation for horses are limited and always under considerable pressure. Reservations will only be accepted by written request (Stable Booking Form) to the show office, together with relevant payment & stable cleaning deposit. The Horse Committee reserves

the right to charge competitors for boxes left unclean and to allocate boxes according to size of the horse/galloway/pony. A limited number of stallion boxes are available for use but priority is given to stallions.

**Rates: \$15 per box per night up to 4 nights or
\$75.00 flat rate per box for an extended stay of up to 10 days
\$20.00 Compulsory stable cleaning deposit**

Stable Cleaning Deposit: A compulsory stable cleaning deposit has been introduced in 2013. Stables will not be allocated unless this is paid. In order for the return of the deposit stables will need to be inspected prior to departure.

Stallion Boxes: Each year there is a high demand for the Stallion Boxes. The decision has been made that these boxes will be allocated at the discretion of the Horse Committee and STALLIONS will have precedence. Competitors need to be aware that stallion boxes WILL be reallocated to stallions should the need arise. Our Society cannot guarantee any accommodation; therefore you enter on the understanding that you arrange your own care of your horses if necessary.

STRAW

A limited amount is available at \$8.00 Inc GST, per bale

CAMPING

Camping is charged at \$10 per day up to four nights
Extended Stay \$50 for up to 10 days

All campers must purchase a current Horsham Agricultural Society Membership to camp on the grounds and must produce this member's ticket on request.

MEASURING

Measuring is conducted from 8.00am to 9.30am prior to commencement of judging each day

Current height certificates from VAS Ltd, RAS, EV & SHC will be accepted

"Hereunder is set out the regulations relating to the measuring of horses and ponies in classes where height is specified. That height certificate issued by Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria and the Equestrian Australia Victorian Branch Inc. Are duly recognised by the Show Society. All horse and ponies must be exhibited in accordance with the current height certification issued by these respective organisations. Horses and ponies without a current height certificate must be measured by the appointed measurer at the show, prior to being exhibited in a class where height is specified." When measuring a horse or pony, an allowance of 3/8 of an inch for shoes may be made at the direction of the measurer.

If the judge entertains a doubt as to the correctness of a height certificate, he/she has the power to order the exhibit to be re-measured. In such a case the Steward shall accompany the exhibit to the measurer and supervise the re-measuring.

This Show will be conducted strictly under EA rules. Competitors in all classes are to be suitable attired. Prize winners must leave the ring, as directed, after receiving awards.

REGULATIONS

1. Entries will only be received subject to the rules and regulations of the Society and the decisions of the Committee. All exhibits must be a bona fide property if the exhibitor or held by the exhibitor under a written lease recognised by the Society at the time of entry.
2. Every exhibitor or competitor shall be bound by and observe the decisions and directions of the Council.

3. The Council reserves the right to reject at any time any entry or prohibit any persons or animals from competition in any class.
4. The Society's Veterinary Surgeon's decision regarding age shall be final.
5. Motor vehicles, including trucks and stock transports, after unloading, shall be parked as directed by the Society's parking attendants.
6. No ribbons will be permitted on exhibitors except those won during the show.
7. In competitions, competitors under the age of 21 years must supply proof of age with entry. Proof of age will be accepted in the form of birth certificate, extract of birth entry, statutory declaration by either parent, baptismal certificate or head teacher's certificate.
8. Owners entering their horses or ponies do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its officials or members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of any competitions.
9. Animals must be haltered in the ring.
10. EA random swabbing procedures may be imposed the Council also reserves the right to scan for microchip proof of identity of any exhibit.
11. Newcomer – not to have competed under saddle before 1 May 2013
12. Exhibits must be exhibited as Open or Showhunters not both – competitors contravening this rule will be eliminated.
13. Novice class winners NOT eligible for Championships.
14. Protests – to be lodged with deposit of \$100, in writing, to the show office. NO OTHER FORM OF PROTESTS WILL BE CONSIDERED
