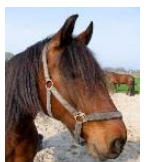
127th Annual Show - Saturday 19 November 2016 HORSE PROGRAM

Horse Regulations & General Information

1. All entries and associated fees to be taken to the Horse Ticket Tent (Office) located at Arena Gate A (refer to enclosed map)
 2. Ticket Tent opens at 7am Show Day. *Note: Numbers system is being used (ie one number per Exhibit)*
 3. Entries will not be accepted unless Horse Entry & Waiver Form has been completed and signed by the Exhibitor
 4. Please have your Entry & Waiver Form completed, signed and have the correct entry money in hand, prior to presenting at the Ticket Tent to avoid delays. **Entry Fee is \$5 for each Event**
 5. The Waiver Form must be signed/completed. If under the age of 18 years, a Parent or Guardian must sign on their behalf. Any Exhibitor failing to sign the Waiver will forfeit any qualification/prize money. Name/address to be supplied. Please print clearly on Entry forms
 6. (a) The use of tranquilisers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance or behavior of animals, is strictly forbidden
(b) Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and testing of all animals is at the owner's risk
(c) Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under veterinary supervision
(d) The attention of Exhibitors is particularly drawn to the conditions relating to misuse of drugs, and that the Committee may undertake random testing for forbidden substances
 7. **For Safety:** once judging has commenced only Exhibits being judged are permitted on the Arena
 8. Horse Exhibitors may produce a current Height Certificate recognised by RAS, EV, VAS Ltd, SHCV or Affiliated Shows to Stewards prior to Judging. Measuring of Exhibits without a Certificate will be available between 8am-9am (refer to map for Measuring Area)
 9. All Competitors enter entirely at their own risk. Ground Stewards have the power to evict horses not properly restrained on Showgrounds
 10. There are no boxes, stalls or stabling facilities available. It is advisable to bring your own yards. Do not affix baling twine or ties to posts, trees or rails. Camping is permitted. Horse Parking enter via Greenvale Lane. Main Entry to Grounds is 50 Mt Battery Road (refer map)
 11. Breed Classes: Exhibits must be registered with their respective Societies and Stud Books. Proof of registration may be requested
 12. First Season Classes: Exhibits must not have been exhibited under saddle prior to 01/08/16. First Show must be in Victoria
 13. Novice: Not have won a Novice Class competing singularly at an Agricultural Show
 14. Local: Resident of Mansfield Shire
 15. No Stallions allowed in Open Rings (Rings 1, 2 & 3)
 16. The Committee reserves the right to change or delete any Class and also reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without citing reason for doing so
 17. VAS Ltd Rules (03.01.12): In Rings 1 & 2 – once a Hack, Galloway or Pony has won a Champion in one Ring, it is not eligible to compete in its Height Class in another Ring. Exhibits can only be shown as Open or Hunter
 18. **Please note:** A rider falling from their horse in a Riding Class is not eligible to remount and continue in that Class, but may continue to compete in other Classes (but only if cleared as fit to continue by the First Aid official)
 19. **Approved helmets must be worn by all Competitors.** If a Competitor enters the arena without a helmet, they will be asked to dismount immediately. This is the Rule of Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd. It is compulsory for everyone competing on a horse working, schooling or riding for any other reason at a Show or in any area considered to be part of the Showgrounds. (Rule applies to all VASL Affiliated Agricultural Societies)
 20. When a class is age-restricted, eg. Smartest on Parade, Junior Riding Classes and Children's Mounts - please note top boots or gaiters cannot be worn by a Competitor under the age of 18yrs
 21. Show rings are available for riders to warm up prior to events (from 6am). Arena must be cleared by 8.30 am no exceptions
 22. Classes will not be held up if an Exhibitor's other Classes clash. To avoid disappointment and missing your Class, marshal outside designated gate two to three Classes before your Class
 23. Champion Winners from Rings 1, 2 & 3 are eligible to compete for Supreme Champion Hack, Galloway, Pony, Hunter and Rider
 24. Queries on Show Day – please address any queries or concerns to the Ringmaster
 25. Champions and Reserve Champions in Open Rings 1, 2 & 3 are eligible to compete at VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships Jan 2017
- Grand Parade at 2.00pm.** You are invited to Marshal at 1.45pm and enter via Gate A. Supreme Exhibits (led or ridden), Champions, Reserves and prize-money winners are required to Parade, showing off sashes and ribbons. **All Exhibitors are welcome in the Parade** (especially Pony Clubbers). Children under 8yrs must be accompanied by an adult. Prize winners will be given a card to present at the Secretary's Office for collection of prize money after the Grand Parade concludes.

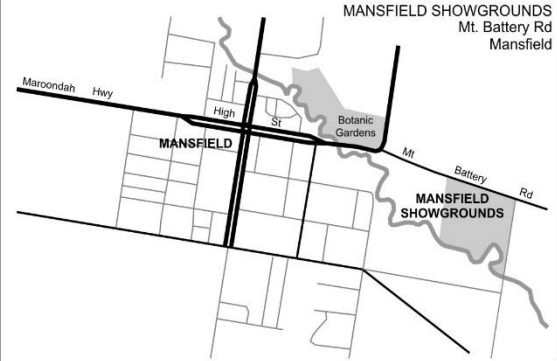
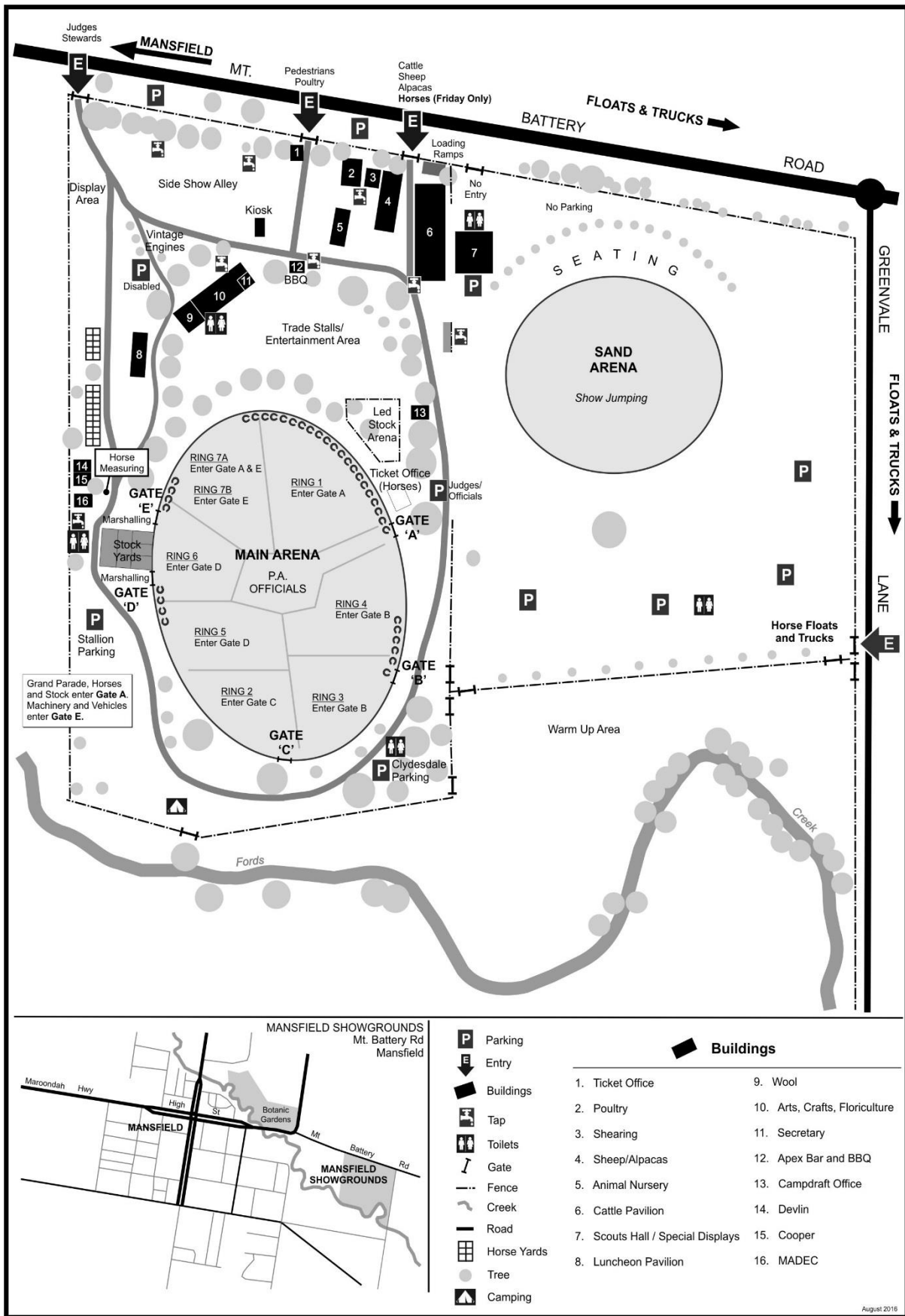

HORSE SPORTS PARTICIPANT RISK ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & WAIVER

Name of Participant: (print name clearly)

1. Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd and Mansfield Agricultural & Pastoral Society Inc. (together the "Suppliers") advise that participation in horse sports at an agricultural show or horse competition contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. Horse sports are dangerous recreational activities and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt. By signing this Waiver, I acknowledge that:
 - 1.1 Participation in horse sports is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - 1.2 Participation in horse sports requires certain skills. I declare that I have sufficient skills to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
 - 1.3 Horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud unfamiliar noises;
 - 1.4 If held at an Agricultural Show, the horse sports will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten horses;
 - 1.5 As the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me and to my horse as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
 - 1.6 Insects or other animals may cause my horse or other horses to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way;
 - 1.7 There is inherent in horse riding the risk of suffering injury including falling from my horse;
 - 1.8 I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for safely and properly participating in the event; and
 - 1.9 I use the facilities of the Mansfield Agricultural & Pastoral Society Inc. entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me;
 - 1.10 This document constitutes a contractual waiver pursuant to Section 22 of the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 (ACLFTA). In that regard, I have initialled the "warning" contained at the end of this document.
2. If I suffer harm while participating in a horse event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any injuries I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided.
3. I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the horse sports and associated activities are a danger and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur and I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in any way whatsoever arising from or in connection with these activities.
4. I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the horse sports and agree that such use may result in me being excluded from an event with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.
5. I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd as varied from time to time.
