Since commencing in 1993, the Standardbred Pleasure and Performance Horse Association of Victorian has raised the profile of the retired harness racehorse. This is evidenced in that the Standardbred now has its own ring at some 20 shows throughout Victoria as well as shows put on by the SPPHAV – our State Championships in led, ridden and rider; in harness and our State Championships in Dressage and Showjumping.

As the profile of the Standardbred has risen in the show ring, so has its popularity. These wonderfully natured horses are now a popular choice throughout Australia and, apart from in the show ring, you will find them being used by RDA groups, for pleasure riding, pleasure driving, endurance, trail riding, three day eventing and more. Is there another horse that demonstrates such versatility?

Join the SPPHAV and help continue the work that has already been so successful. Work that has seen the demand for these horses increase and the open prejudice becoming a thing of the past.

We are offering an extended membership period for those who join and register their horse to contest at this show. We are also waiving the compulsory administration fee for new members.

Participation at this show is open to members with horses registered with the SPPHAV and all members who enter the show ring must be 30 years old or over.

If you are a new member and will register your horse with us, on receipt of the above fees, membership and horse registration forms will be provided to facilitate membership and horse registration processes for the remainder of the current financial year and for 2017 – 2018 providing 14 months of membership. New partbred registrations require DNA verification and this is not possible prior to this show.

A Standardbred horse can contest Foundation and Novice Ridden classes OR Novice and Open Ridden classes in the ridden section, but not all 3 classes.

NOTE: This ring is open to purebred or partbred Standardbred horses, registered with the SPPHAV only. Leaders / riders must also be a current financial member of the SPPHAV and must be 30 years of age or over.

Please Note: the Committee has included the judging of a Supreme Ridden Exhibit in this program to encourage owners / riders of female horses to compete. If entries are low, the program will be changed in 2018 to exclude that opportunity.

Similarly, we have included Novice and Foundation classes to encourage all members, 30 years of age or over, to bring your horses out to this show.

REMEMBER – this ring is being held as a Winter Woollies show so plaiting is **not allowed and no exceptions**. This makes preparation for the day a whole lot easier.
