Measuring can be done at the Goroke A & P Society's Show by prior arrangement ONLY

Age of competitors

The age of all competitors is to be the actual age of the competitor on the day of the show. Proof of age must be produced on request.

The committee reserves the right to alter any sections or events contained in this schedule if deemed necessary.

The committee may refuse entries with no correspondence to be entered into.

The Goroke A & P Society's Horses in Action Program will be held in accordance with current EA Show Horse rules (as amended). The height certificates issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria and the Equestrian Federation of Australia Victorian Branch incorporated, are duly recognised by this show society, and horses and ponies must be exhibited with current height certificates.

SWABBING

Random swabbing and horse registration checks may take place at any time. A \$3.00 swabbing fee per horse is to be paid by all entrants. Fees to be held by WASA in a special fund for the continuation of Random Annual Swabbing at all Wimmera Shows.

Stallions

Stallions are ineligible to compete in rings 1, 2 and 3. Stallions must be identified as wearing a green stallion disk, any stallion posing a danger will be asked to be removed from the grounds, please keep stallions separate to other competitors

Exercising horses

Horses are permitted to exercise on the main arena prior to 8am after this time please use the warm up areas. Lunging on main arena will only be permitted until 8am. After this time there is to be no lunging on main arena.

Dogs

Please keep dogs on a lead at all times. Loose dogs will be impounded and fees will apply.

## Breeds ring

This section is for horses and ponies registered with the appropriate breed Society. Horse registration and current financial membership MUST be produced at the time of entry. Failure to comply with these rules will entail elimination.

This ring/show will be conducted under HRCAV Rules for members of clubs affiliated with the HRCAV. Host club is the Mid South East Dressage Club. Members must present their current financial membership card and performance card to the card secretary prior to ring commencing. Entries on the day must be on official HRCAV entry form. Sashes to 4th in Smartest on Parade.

All competitors in arena events to compete at their own risk. Waiver forms enclosed with schedule must be filled in and signed.

Supreme Champion Ridden Exhibit of the show to be judged from Champion Ponies, Galloways and Hacks and will be judged at the completion of all Championships in rings 1 and 2.

Entries in breeds ring/registered events, HRCAV and Pony Club classes must show appropriate papers when filling in waiver forms.

Winners of championships in ring 1 MAY NOT compete in ring 2 in a similar event in which they went onto become champion.

1st, 2nd and 3rd award ribbons/sashes/rosettes will be given in all horse sections.

Entrants will receive an entry number which is to be worn for the duration of competition. This will only be available from the secretaries office on the morning of the show after waiver forms have been completed.

Horses may compete as either Show Hunter or Show Hack but not both.

## **Competitors in rings 1 and 2 are not permitted to compete in ring 3**

A NOVICE is classified as not having won an event in an open class in any agricultural show.

There will be no holding up of rings. If two events clash, the competitors must choose which they will compete in.

## Protests

All protests must be in writing with a \$100 cash bond be given to the Horse committee, if the protest is upheld you will get your money back, if not your money will be forfeited.

#### QUALIFIER REGULATIONS

1. Open to all purebred freeze branded Standardbreds registered with Harness Racing Australia. Raced or unraced. Registrations will be verified.
2. Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number must be provided.
3. Qualifying Shows must be VAS Ltd affiliated.
4. Qualifying Classes will be judged **ridden**.
5. Once a Qualifier has been won, the horse is ineligible to compete in another Qualifier.
6. All Qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the HERO Series Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championship.
7. Riders to be aged 14 years and over on the day of the Qualifying Show.
8. To be judged as a good example of a Standardbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration  
Standardbred qualities Conformation  
Manners, paces and performance  
Racing related injuries and/or blemishes are permitted
9. The Judge's Decision is final in the Qualifiers and Final.
10. Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50 Cheque sent out once qualification has been verified, and HERO Gift Pack (Gift Pack collected at State Final).

***Champions in ring 1 may not compete in ring 2 in a similar event in which they went on to become Champion.***

## HERO SERIES FINAL REGULATIONS

1. To have qualified at a Qualifying Show in a HERO Series Class.
2. Horse to be entered under Registered/Racing name where available.
3. Expected to walk, trot and canter with change of rein.
4. Judge may ride horses in final.
5. If judge does not ride exhibits, competitors will be asked to do an individual workout and show walk, trot and canter on both reins, finishing with a halt and salute to the judges.
6. Other regulations for the Final
7. In the event of one rider going through to the Final with more than one horse, they must nominate a substitute rider.
8. An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his/her employer.
9. An exhibitor may not show a horse judged by any member of his/her immediate family.
  - An exhibitor may not show under a judge that they have produced an equine for within the past 24 months.

**VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy** *Open to girls and boys who have won a 'Good Hands' competition at a local show*

**Background** The VAS Saddle Horse Championships began in 1996. The VASA Committee determined to introduce an event that would not only showcase champion horses and riders from across country Victoria, but in turn increase exhibitor numbers at country shows. The 'Best of the Best' event has grown steadily and is now recognised as a 'competitor friendly Championships'. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is held during the Saddle Horse Championships. The Championships will again be held at the Prince of Wales Showgrounds in Bendigo.

### **Good Hands Challenge Trophy**

#### **Rules and Regulations – local show**

1. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is conducted at the VAS Saddle Horse Championships
2. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is open to boys and girls aged **10 years and under 15 years** on the day of the local show/field day
3. Result (Name, Address and DOB) to be included on Horse Result Sheet.
4. All VAS affiliated shows/field days are invited to hold qualifying competitions. Show societies are encouraged to run one class at the local show which includes girls and boys
5. The competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability - mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account
6. Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony
7. Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and made of the same type of metal, with or without a cavesson on the noseband
8. A gear check may take place
9. **Please note: straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.**

Horse sports are dangerous recreational activities and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

By signing this waiver I acknowledged that:

Participation in horse sports is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me; Participation in horse sports requires certain skills. I declare that I have sufficient skills to be able to safely and properly participate in the events; Horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises; If held at an agricultural show, the horse sports will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten horses; as the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me and to my horse as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind; Insects or other animals may cause my horse or other horses to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way; There is inherent in horse riding events the risk of suffering injury including falling from my horse; I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for safely and properly participating in the event; and I use the facilities of *Goroke Agricultural & Pastoral Society* entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.

If I suffer harm while participating in a horse event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any injuries I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided. I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the horse sports and associated activities are a danger and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur and I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in any way whatsoever arising from or in connection with these activities. I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the horse sports and agree that such use may result in me being excluded from an event with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers. I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd as varied from time to time.

I agree that I have read and understood this waiver prior to signing it and agree that this waiver will be binding on my heirs, next of kin, executors and administrators.

I agree that this waiver shall be governed in all respects by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Victoria.
