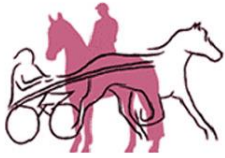

## Which level to enter?

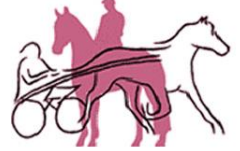
- Novice horses are not to have won a prior novice series. Previous winners must enter the open section.
- If you compete in HRC AV or PCAV, and are graded at grade 4 and above then you must enter Open
- Novice series is offered to horses which DO NOT have an established canter, or those that are EXTREMELY green under saddle or very new to dressage and competing. The Committee reserves right to advise non-novice horse and rider combinations that they are considered not to be a novice and will be moved into the open section if rider wishes, or given a refund
- If you have queries about your novice status please phone Shelley or Sheridan

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Open dressage will consist of a pure and partbred section, Novice horses are combined.
- A horse cannot have a change of rider during any level of these competitions.
- Dressage tests will be conducted under SPPHAV dressage rules which are available on our website
- All competitors must report to gear check before their first test of the day
- Test callers are allowed, please arrange your own
- This is a member only competition, and all horses must be registered with the SPPHAV
- All riders are to supply their own numbers (x2) to be displayed on the bridle or saddle blanket
- All riders are to wear approved safety helmets and boots. Snaffle bits only, all levels.
- Dress Code – Round 1 SPPHAV polo or jacket, plaiting optional  
- State Championships and Round 2 Jacket and horses must be plaited

- High Jump:** The SPPHAV annual High Jump Competition is open to anyone who wishes to participate.
- Two jumps will be set up, a vertical and oxar. Starting height of 60cm, and riders take turns going over a fence. Once all riders have completed a fence, the height goes up 5-10cm, and riders go again. Combinations who knock or refuse a fence are eliminated.
  - Last horse and rider standing win.
  - We encourage members to have fun and give it a go, but to not push above their limit.
  - This is a free event, we encourage members to have fun and give it a go.

**Combined Training Competition:**

Competitors who wish to be eligible for the combined training award must have done – 5.2 or EA Preliminary 1A dressage test the day before. The combined training competition award you are eligible for is based on your jumping height.
